PNCC offers the highest 4G LTE speeds on Palau's largest network. Take advantage of our Prepaid Data Bundle options.

What type of device do I need to use PNCC mobile data?

Smartphones and tablets that can support the PNCC mobile network bands: 4G-LTE and 3G-UMTS

Where is mobile data service available?

Mobile data service is offered from Kayangel to Angaur.

What is the rate for mobile data service? Save with prepaid data plans: dial *780# for info.

Prepaid Mobile Data Rate: 16¢/MB (without plan)
Prepaid voice rates:16¢/mn off-peak, 23¢/mn peak.
Peak: 6:00AM-5:59PM Off-peak: 6:00PM-5:59AM
SMS/Text: SEND: 6¢ local; 21¢ international (160 characters), FREE to receive.

How do I access mobile data service?

- Mobile data settings are automatically preset on all new PNCC Mobile SIM cards.
- Note: 4G Pocket WiFi Rental Service provides another option for mobile data, convenient for smartphones that are not compatible with PNCC network specifications, or locked to their home operator.





SAVE WITH PREPAID MOBILE DATA PLANS (Dial *780# for info)*

Before activating any prepaid data plan, turn off mobile data. Turn data on only when you wish to go online, to prevent unwanted background data charges.



How can I make international calls from my cellphone?

Both local and long distance calls can be made with a prepaid SIM card. Dial overseas calls using a "plus sign" as the international access code:



Example to Guam (671), USA(1):

+1 671 2345678

How are calls charged?

- Both incoming calls received and outgoing calls made from your cellular number are charged.
- All voice calls are calculated on a one-minute minimum.
- International calls incur a per minute airtime charge as well as the applicable long distance rate.
- Calls to 611(PNCC trouble reports) and 911(emergency) are FREE and can be made even if you are out of Airtime or your number is suspended, as long as your SIM is valid.

The official currency is the US Dollar. VISA, JCB, and MasterCard are widely accepted at stores and visitor facilities. There are FDIC Insured banks and major hotels with limited foreign currency exchange and ATMs.

Eco-paradise FM, a government-owned radio station on 87.9 (89.1 in Babeldaob) and three privately-owned stations on FM89.5 or 88.5 in Babeldaob (WWFM), 88.9 (KRFM) and 89.9 (PWFM) offer a variety of local Palauan and International music. PNCC Digital TV, operated by Palau National Communications Corporation (PNCC) offers over 65 channels including CNN, Fox News, BBC News, ESPN, and NHK, shown satellite direct 24 hours a day, as well as popular U.S. entertainment and children's programming, plus several movie channels. There are two local newspapers, Island Times and Tia Belau. See Radio Broadcasters and Publishing in the Yellow Pages.
